## Part 800.24 - DOH Required Equipment

Cot, wheeled with 2 web straps to secure patient  
Device, carrying for a 2nd patient with 2 web straps to secure patient  
Chair, stair with 2 web straps to secure patient  
BVM, Adult  
BVM, Child  
Airways, oropharyngeal, 4 adult sizes  
Airways, oropharyngeal, 2 each newborn, infant and child  
Oxygen, portable "D" size with pressure gauge, regulator & flow meter (minimum 1000 PSI)  
Oxygen, portable "D" spare cylinder (minimum 1000 PSI)  
Oxygen, vehicle mounted (minimum 12 PSI)  
Masks, non-rebreather oxygen, 4 each  
Masks, oxygen clear face with inflatable rim, newborn, infant & child  
Cannulae, adult nasal oxygen, 4 each  
Suction, portable (vacuum greater than 300 mm)  
Suction, vehicle mounted (vacuum greater than 300 mm)  
Pharyngeal tips, Yankauer-type, 2 each  
Catheters, suction, 2 each sizes 5, 8,10 french  
Syringe, small bulb( 2)  
Humidification, disposable oxygen, setup
